Born in Prachatitz, Bohemia and after completing theological studies at the University of Prague, he went to New York City in 1836 where he was ordained a priest on June 25 for the Diocese of New York. He was assigned to the Niagara Falls Area on upstate New York to work with recent German immigrants.

#### **58<sup>th</sup> Annual State Golf Tournament, September 28/29 SUN 'N LAKE GOLF CLUB Sebring, FL**

Our Lady of Grace Council 14717 is sponsoring the 2013 State Golf Tournament at the Sun 'N Lake Golf Club, located at 5223 Sun 'N Lake Boulevard in Sebring. Both men and women – up to 144 in all (two courses) - are invited to participate, through a variety of golf/banquet packages. Forward, Gold and White tees will be used, depending on handicap and gender. The entry fee is \$130, and covers two rounds of golf, the banquet and a "Goody Bag" that includes two mulligans. The tournament will feature a \$2,000 prize for a hole-in-one, also competition for closest to the pin on all par threes, and the longest drive.

The Registration Period will last from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM on Friday, September 27, and will be complemented by hors d'oeuvres and a Cash Bar. Saturday's Registration will take place from 7:00 AM to 8:00 AM. Saturday's banquet menu will include Prime Rib and Tilapia. Vigil Mass will be celebrated on Saturday at 4:00 PM at Our Lady of Grace Church at 595 East Main Street. Three area hotels are available for accommodations.

The tournament should prove to be a fun-filled weekend which will provide opportunity to meet and golf with Brother Knights from other areas of the State. Since the State Golf Tournament is a fundraiser, participants will also experience the satisfaction of benefiting those who need material encouragement.
